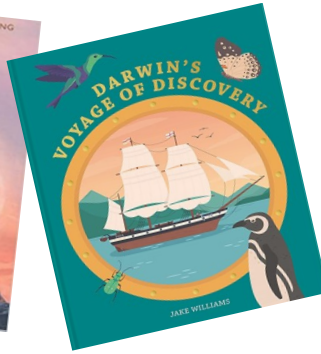




## Parents information sheet

**Year 5/6— Last term's golden nuggets were:**
