Last term's golden nuggets were:

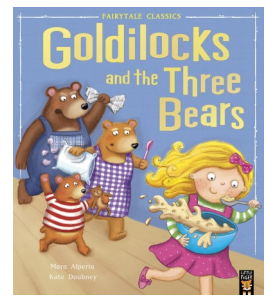
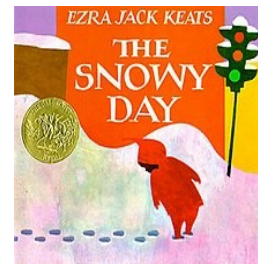
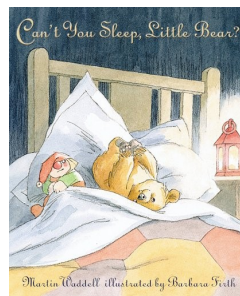
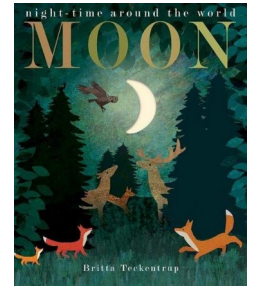
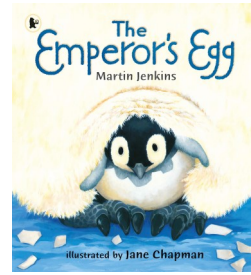
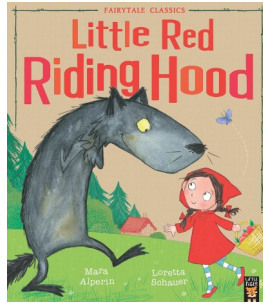
1. What changes happen in Autumn? We looked at how the weather changes from summer to autumn what happens to the trees.
